1. How will we get access to the Presentation?

The Presentation Day will be over the Zoom platform. If you wish to join us please contact your team manager or email steve.mann@cityyouthfc.com for details.

2. What is the password?

Access to the Presentation is password protected. If you wish to join us please contact your team manager or email steve.mann@cityyouthfc.com for details.

3. Is it ok to share the password with friends and family?

Yes but do NOT publish the password on any social Media Channels. Please only share the password on 'closed' messaging services (Family & Team Whatsapp groups).

4. When will my team(s) sessions be?

Please see the timetable above.

5. How are you ensuring that our young people are safeguarded during the Presentation Day?

A risk assessment has been completed. Access is password protected. No images on slides can be directly attributable to player's names. Other than designated 'Hosts' all participants cameras and will be 'off' and participants will be muted.

6. When can I join the Presentation Day?

Access will be available from 9.55 am and then 5 minutes before the scheduled start of all further sessions. All participants will be held in a 'Waiting Room' until 10 am (and subsequent start times). If you are 'late' don't worry, as soon as you 'arrive' you will be placed in a 'waiting room' and then given access.

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7. Do we have to remain for the whole session or whole day?

No. You are free to remain or leave at any time.

8. How do I communicate with you if I have trouble gaining access / logging in?

Please use your 'age group' City Youth Whatsapp Group and Steve will try and help out.

9. Will we be able to speak and otherwise participate?

Unfortunately, no. On the advice of the team at Zoom only the 'hosts' will be able to be seen and heard.

10. Is there a Dress Code this year?

11. What format is the Presentation Day?

It is a very simple PowerPoint presentation.

12. When will POTY Trophies be physically presented?

The Trophies have been ordered from the supplier and will be held there until safe to collect/deliver them. We will keep the winners and Managers posted with when this will be.

13. What awards will be made on the day?

Where they have been awarded by teams, the Player of The Year (in a handful of cases joint) will be announced. We will also honour all players who have passed their 100 & 200 appearance milestones.

14. We have other awards to give out such as Clubman of the Year etc. Will those be announced?

No. Individual managers and coaches will need to make their own arrangements for any additional rewards. The Club suggests scheduling another Zoom call amongst your team and having parents present again for safeguarding reasons.
